## Elaine Ruth Long April 3, 1936 - March 29, 2017



A life well-lived, countless lives touched

You've probably heard the story about thirteen brave Iowa teachers back in 1981 who helped to shape the course of education in Iowa by banding together and forming Professional Educators of Iowa.

We lost one of those thirteen founding members this past week with the passing of Elaine Long, a beloved teacher and friend to Iowa educators. Elaine was a graduate of Northwestern College in Minneapolis and received her Masters from Drake University. She taught music education for 39 years in Des Moines Public School and Des Moines Christian School. She also taught piano and voice lessons privately.

Elaine continued to be active with Professional Educators of Iowa as an advocate and annually attended the PEI conferences. She will be greatly missed!

## Introducing Payroll Deduction Life Insurance

PEI is pleased to announce the introduction of a new option for our members to purchase life insurance through Independent Insurance Services agent, Doug Joslin. Payroll deduction life insurance allows you to purchase insurance services from a professional agent through your school district of employment. In the event of a claim, you can use your insurance proceeds to help with unpaid medical bills, income replacement for survivors, and final expenses such as burial costs.

This policy will not be canceled as long as you pay your premiums on time. To ensure that this remains the case, your premiums are paid through the convenience of payroll deduction. This means no bills to remember and no checks to write. In addition, the policy is portable, meaning if you leave your employer or retire, you may continue coverage by paying the premiums directly to the insurance company at the same price with no change in coverage.

You determine the coverage that fits your budget, with plans starting for as little as \$2 per week. No medical exams are required, although issuance of the policy may depend on answers to health-related questions in the application. If you apply for \$200,000 or more, your agent will arrange for you to do a blood profile and urine analysis and check your height, weight, blood pressure and pulse.

Coverage is also available for your spouse, children, stepchildren, legally adopted children and grandchildren, ages 15 days through 18 years. You may also apply for a policy for your children ages 19 through 25 who are full-time students, unmarried and not in military service.

To take advantage of this, you simply need to talk with your superintendent or payroll clerk and get them to approve payroll deduction of your life insurance premiums. If they agree, Mr. Joslin will come to the school and explain the insurance to any prospective clients interested in learning more about this offer.
